Get a Copy of Your Birth Certificate

Your birth certificate is the most important document you will need to prove your legal identity and age. You will need it to apply for a passport or government benefits, enroll in school, join the military, or claim a pension or insurance benefits. If you need a copy, where you were born will determine how to obtain a copy of it.

If you were born in the United States:

For a certified copy of your birth certificate, contact the [office of vital records](#) in the state where you were born for instructions on how to request a copy and any fees. If you need to get a copy of your birth certificate quickly, ask the vital records office at the time you place the order about expedited service or shipping.

New York State Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV)- State Issued Identification (Non-Driver's ID) & State Issued Driver's License:

Photo identification can be obtained at any Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) in your area. If you have a valid NYS DMV photo ID not expired more than 2 years, you have enough points to get your ID. If not, you will need to show proof of date of birth along with proof of name. Contact your local DMV to find out what you need to bring with you to prove your identity.

If your driver's license was recently lost or stolen, contact your local DMV.

You can apply for Medicaid in any one of the following ways: online, mail, phone, or go to the nearest department of social services. To apply online, visit the New York State Department of Health website.

Social Security:

Application: www.ssa.gov/forms/ss-5.pdf

You must present original documents or copies certified by the agency that issued them. Photocopies or notarized copies will not be accepted. All documents must be current (not expired). Receipts showing you applied for the document will not be accepted.

Proof of Identity:

Only certain documents are accepted as proof of identity. An acceptable document must be current (not expired) and show your name, identifying information (date of birth) and recent photograph:

**United States Driver's License;
State-issued non-driver identification card;
Or a United States Passport**

If you do not have one of these specific documents or cannot get a replacement of one of them within 10 days, we will ask to see other documents. Any documents submitted, including the following, must be current (not expired) and show your name, identifying information (date of birth) and preferably a recent photograph:

**Employee Identification Card;
School Identification Card;
Health Insurance Card (Medicare not accepted)
Or a U.S. Military Identification Card**

Note: We may use one document for two purposes. For example, we may use your U.S. Passport as proof of both citizenship and identity.
